Single Program Day Programs

Single day programs are appropriate for groups who want a single experience or a wide variety of offerings in the program. This type of program is perfect for students that don't have a lot of experience with hands-on learning or are new to science concepts. This is also great for a school that is starting a science club program.

Students will learn about how ice is formed and create a beautiful picture using "paint pops." They will also explore the concept of temperature by using thermometers which they will be able to take home.

Children will get an up close look as some of their favorite bugs while learning how to answer the question, "Is that an insect?"
